DESCRIPTION

The realization of the ambitious Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) will require the engagement of all development actors. Considerable stock has been placed in multi-stakeholder partnerships (MSPs) as a means to progress. Yet it cannot be assumed that MSPs – whether involving dialogue or joint action – will simply coalesce, nor that they will be inclusive of varied development actors. The diverse development actors expected to engage in MSPs alongside national governments – civil society organizations (CSOs), local and regional governments, parliamentarians, and the private sector, amongst others – each have varied power, interests and needs that affect their ability to engage. This session will address the key enabling environment challenges these development actors face as well as actions that can be taken by GPEDC stakeholders to address these challenges.
